The Serengeti ecosystem is a geographical region in Africa. It is located in northern Tanzania. It spans approximately



30,000 km² (12,000 sq.ml).

The Serengeti hosts the second largest terrestrial mammal migration in the world, which helps secure it as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa, and as one of the ten natural travel wonders of the world. The Serengeti is also renowned for its large lion population and is one of the best places to observe prides in their natural environment. The region

contains the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania and several game reserves.

Approximately 70 large mammal and 500 bird species are found there. This high diversity is a function of diverse habitats, including riverine forests, swamps, kopjes, grasslands, and woodlands. Blue wildebeests, gazelles, zebras, and buffalos are some of the commonly found large mammals in the region.

GRUMETI MIGRATION CAMP

With a menu that features seasonal local cuisine, along with well-known international dishes.

Unwind and engage at a comfortable and refined setting with the impressive views over the camp - it is truly nature's own feature as the lounge area harmoniously showcases the magical environment - from its enormous skies, wheat-coloured plains and abundant wildlife.

The Boma - A romantic camp-side for evenings under the stars. Guests congregate at the boma to enjoy pre-dinner story telling by staff and reflect on the day's safari adventures. We have a fully stocked bar with a wide range of international spirits and wines.







SERENGETI SIMBA LODGE

Serengeti Simba Lodge, named after the lion (*Simba* in Swahili) king of the jungle, a symbol of strength, pride and royalty—sits high on a hill with endless vistas of the great Serengeti plains. We welcome you to explore, experience and enjoy the African wilderness and the amazing Serengeti as our guest at Serengeti Simba Lodge.

The 'Serengeti Migration' passes the lodge twice a year, around June-July and again in October when millions of ungulates make their annual trek through the Serengeti eco-system. With awe-



inspiring panoramic views of the vast savannah, Serengeti Simba Lodge is home to prolific birdlife and a stunning array of large game including: lion, buffalo, cheetah, leopard, giraffe, elephant, bush buck, zebra, gazelle and hartebeest.

Night game drives and performances by the Simba Dance Troupe will add to the experience of spectacular sunrise and sunset. At night listen to the trumpeting of elephant, the laughing hyenas and the roars of our namesake.

The common area of the lodge (reception, bar and dining) is built around a 'kopje' or rocky outcropping, providing an unusual and natural background for your enjoyment. But the one thing everyone comments on is the amazing views of the Serengeti to be seen from every vantage point on Serengeti Simba Lodge's grounds.

Children over age six are most welcome at the lodge and must be under parent's supervision at all time. Children under the age of thirteen must share a room with an adult (17 or older). There are two large family rooms in our Stone House.



TWC MOBILE CAMPS

MOBILE CAMPS: An original form of accommodation which resembles the old camps of the first explorers in Africa, with all the commodities of today.

Kati Kati Tented Camp - Immerse yourself in nature in this bush-camp. Kati Kati is a mobile camp strategically situated in central Serengeti, ideal for exploring the extensive Serengeti plains. The camp offers comfortable accommodation together with the unique opportunity to enjoy a real safari experience on a camp. In its comfortable tents one will feel completely immersed in the surroundings and one can enjoy the rich animal life and vegetation of the area.

Mara Kati Kati Tented Camp - is a mobile camp strategically situated in north Serengeti, ideal for exploring the extensive Serengeti plains. The camp offers comfortable accommodation together with the unique opportunity to enjoy a real safari experience on a camp. In its comfortable tents one will feel completely immersed in the surroundings and one can enjoy the rich animal life and vegetation.

Ndutu Kati Tented Camp - Is a seasonal mobile camp strategically situated in south Serengeti from December to March. Ideal for exploring the extensive south of Serengeti and witness the migration.



SERENGETI SOPA LODGE

Located on the edge of the escarpment overlooking the plains of the south-western Serengeti National Park, home to many thousands of wild and rare animals, Serengeti Sopa Lodge lies within an area of out-standing natural beauty. An oasis of cool relaxation from the equatorial sun.

The lodge allows its guests to experience magnificent sights and enjoy interaction with the land and animals difficult to find elsewhere, whilst at the same time enjoying the highest level of cuisine and hospitality.

Unlike most other safari lodges throughout East Africa, our main building does not have a traditionally African thatched roof. It has instead a flat roof which we often use for cocktail, sundowner and private parties.

However, when you step down from these lofty heights into the sudden coolness of the reception lobby and move on, you will find stairs and ramps which either take you down to the dining room, with its outdoor terrace and simply delicious and sumptuous meals that are to die for, or across to the conference room before descending further to the ground floor.



LAHIA TENTED LODGE

The camp is strategically located at the top of a hill overlooking Central Serengeti with views towards Western Serengeti, within reach of mythical locations such as the famous kopjes Masais, the museum at the Olduvai gorge, Seronera valley and the Grumeti river.

The main house offers a unique 360 ^o panoramic view of the landscape. The building contains lounges, a dining room and a swimming pool. It has been decorated in a modern African style creating a fresh and bright atmosphere, cosy, but with a touch of luxury. Guests can observe the Great Migration spectacle from the comfort of their tents.

Stylish tent build on wooden platforms with en-suite facilities overlooking Serengeti National Park. All rooms feature a balcony with views.

The camp has a main area built on a raised deck where the dining room and lounge are situated. This is where the dining room and lounge are situated. The lounge is furnished with comfortable



sofas and armchairs and there is a selection of board games available. The installations have a swimming pool where guests can relax after a day on safari. Internet is available in communal areas.

Every evening a fire is lit outside where guests can relax and contemplate the sunset whilst enjoying a sundowner (a drink).

UNDER CANVAS LUXURY CAMPS

Under Canvas Camps offer a glamping experience in Serengeti. The group comprises of THREE camps located at different strategic locations. All camps offer 10 tents.

Bologonya Under Canvas changes location three times a year within north Serengeti to be able to be in the heart of the Great Migration, from the plains where the wildebeest have their young to the humid pastures at the end of the route.

In Bologonya Under Canvas you will enjoy days of emotion and safari trying to trap with your eyes and your camera the Big Five

Mara Under Canvas is the closest camp to the river Mara where each year enormous columns of wildebeest cross the river, negotiating the jaws of the hungry crocodiles, in order to get to the pastures on the other side in what could be considered the climax of the Great Migration.

This luxury temporary camp is open from **June to November**. It allows visitors to be in the proximity of the Great Migration and to be able to explore remote areas and the beautiful settings of Serengeti with a large amount of resident fauna. The camp has only ten double tents and a family tent which assures the intimacy and exclusivity of this intense experience.

Ndutu Under Canvas - Situated between the centre and south of Serengeti. Between December and March this is the most important area of the Migration spectacle.

The camp has three different locations during the year depending on the movements of the Migration.

This luxury camp allows guests to be in the proximities of the Great Migration and to explore remote areas and the beautiful settings of Serengeti with a large quantity of resident wildlife.
